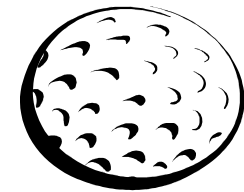

FCA Golf Challenge Explained

How does this Fundraiser Work?

Unlike a traditional golf fundraiser, this golf event is **NOT** a “pay to play” tournament.

There is **NO** financial obligation from the golfer who participates unless they choose to give.

Each golfer's goal is to make **Fifty (50)** contacts via letter, phone, email, or meeting and tell the individual what you are doing and ask for their sponsorship.

Our past records have shown that if a golfer makes 50 contacts, then they generally will raise over \$1,000. In addition, you also are communicating to them the importance of the FCA ministry in reaching out to our schools and community.

Each golfer will receive a PLAYER PACKET that will include a PLAYER HANDBOOK with all the items needed for this event.

Captains Meeting

The Golf Committee will hold a Captains Meeting for all Golf Captains to obtain the Packets and Information for their team. This meeting will take place in the first half of February.

In order to thank the golfer who participates, there are individual prize incentives for those reaching the \$1,000 and \$3,000 levels. Also, the top 3 Fund Raising Teams will enjoy a free round of golf and lunch at some extravagant courses. There will be tournament prizes as well for golf play.

Ways to Participate

How Can I Be Involved?

1. Be a Team Captain-

Contact the FCA office and obtain the information about serving as a Golf Captain. The main responsibility is to recruit 3 other golfers who will raise funds in the way explained earlier in this brochure & attend the Captains Meeting. As the captain, you are the point person for your team.

2. Be a Player-

You may participate individually and we will assign you to a team that is not full. Contact the FCA office to obtain all the information.

3. Be a Fundraiser-

Even if you don't play golf, you can still participate in the fundraising by sending out your fifty (50) letters.

4. Be a Sponsor-

- A. Corporate Title Sponsor- \$5,000
- B. Corporate Presenting Sponsor- \$2,000
- C. Corporate Hole Sponsor- \$1,000
- D. Tee Sponsor- \$500
- E. Clubhouse Sponsor- \$250

5. Be a Volunteer-
